Subject:- Renewal of Licences of Brick Kiln-regarding .

NOTICE


1. Whereas, the issuances and renewal of Brick Kiln licenses in J&K was so far governed in terms of the J&K Brick Kilns Regulation Act, 2010 ;and
2. Whereas, the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MOEF) Government of India vide its Notification No. 190 (E) dated 20.01.2016 and O.M. dated 15.03.2016 read with Notification No. S.O 141 (E) dated 15.01.2016, has mandated the setting up of District Expert Appraisal Committee (DEAC) and District Environment Impact Assessment Authority (DEIAA) for the purpose of processing and granting environmental clearance to all activities associated with quarrying and excavation of Minor Minerals ;and
3. Whereas, as such the environmental clearance by District Environment Impact Assessment Authority (DEIAA) shall also henceforth be a pre-requisite for obtaining renewal of Brick Kiln Licences ;and
4. Whereas, the District Environment Impact Assessment Authority (DEIAA) has already been constituted under the chairmanship of District Magistrate, Jammu. The Addl. District Magistrate (Law & Order) shall be the Member Secretary of the District Environment Impact Assessment Authority (DEIAA). The Environmental Clearance shall be accorded by the District Environment Impact Assessment Authority (DEIAA) within 45 days of receipt of recommendations from District Expert Appraisal Committee (DEAC);and
5. Whereas, the District Expert Appraisal Committee (DEAC) has also been constituted under the chairmanship of Superintending Engineer , Flood Control & Irrigation Department. The District Mining Officer is the Member Secretary of District Expert Appraisal Committee (DEAC). The District Expert Appraisal Committee (DEAC) shall meet at least once every month ;and
6. Therefore, it is being brought to the notice of all Brick Kiln licence holders in Jammu district that it shall be mandatory for them to seek renewal of their licences in terms of both the JK Brick Kiln Regulation Act and the above referred notifications of Ministry of Environment and Forest (MOEF), Government of India. The License holders shall apply for renewal as per the below prescribed process:-
